2019 Year in Review

January 2020 News Letter

In 1 Corinthians 3:10 the Apostle Paul says, "By the grace that God has given me, I laid a foundation as a wise builder, and someone else is building it. But each one should build with care." As the founder, builder and Director of Globe Creek Camp I do not want to compare myself to the Great Apostle Paul, but what is happening with the ministry at Globe Creek Camp is similar. Many of you already know that I am semi-retiring from the ministry of GCC and turning it over to another ministry by 2021. I do not remember the exact year, but about five years ago the Lord placed it in my spirit that my wife Marsha and I should get ready to find another ministry to take over GCC and move to Idaho to spend our remaining time with our family there. We shared this with the Board of Directors of Globe Creek Camp, Inc. They agreed and started praying that the Lord would lead and guide us according to His will. Neither of us have lived close to immediate family since high school for the most part, and it is time to do so. I have two sisters and one brother in Idaho and Marsha's mother just moved to Nampa, Idaho, knowing we would be there soon. So after much, much prayer the Lord has led us to a local group last year that has formed a Christian non-profit organization called Alaska Wilderness Adventure Ministries Incorporated. We are already in the transition mode. The camp will continue to be called Globe Creek Camp with the same basic vision that the Lord gave me as founder. The plan is for AWAM to take possession by January 2021. They also will be very involved in the operation of the youth camps this year. I will continue to work with AWAM for several more summers after that to finish the remaining major buildings and infrastructures. We have sold our home here in North Pole and have signed on a home already in Nampa. We will be closing on them both in February, moving to Nampa after Snow Camp later in March. I will return to GCC in May to continue the summer camps and retreats as usual, then return to Nampa in late August.

I will try to keep you updated on the transition this year with more details on the blessed people of AWAM Inc. who will be operating the ministry at Globe Creek Camp. Please pray for AWAM, as this is a huge undertaking, that the Lord would lead and bless them every step of the way.


Snow Camp March 10-12-2019

- Set log walls for 12x20 staff cabin.
- Set 28' ridge poles for staff cabin.
- Installed propane dryer and plumbing for washing machine.
- Finished trim utility room and set tile bases for five pellet stoves.
- Did a ton of organizing for construction and lodge supplies.

West Shore Evangelical Free Mechanicsburg Penn.

August 3-10. - Week 1

- Installed 1x6 T&G on roof of staff cabin.
- Sanded interior of Directors cabin and sealed walls and ridgepoles.
- Trimmed windows doors and installed flooring Directors cabin.
- Prepped cabin walls for installation of pellet stoves.

West Shore Evangelical Free Mechanicsburg Penn.

August 10 – 17– Week 2

- Finished roof of staff cabin.
- Trimmed windows and door of staff cabin. Decking on cabin.
- Cleaned and organized entire site to ready for public zip line event
- Helped operate 2 day public zip line event at Globe Creek Camp.
- By mid-September all five pellet stove installations were complete and ready for the fall retreats to enjoy. Wood is free but these pellet stoves are much safer.

This summer we will build another 12x20 staff cabin which will bring the number of beds available to 58. Summer at GCC is stacking up to be another very busy time with at least four work teams coming. With the AWAM team coming onboard and helping already this summer, we plan to have two adventure summer camps. We also will have at least four zip line weekend public events. These events are a great way to promote the mission of GCC as families, groups and individuals from the Fairbanks area and visitors traveling from all over the world not only get to have some fun on the zip line but see first-hand the awesome facilities and beautiful property that the Lord has blessed us with.
